

To enter your deployment, you will be asked to answer a few questions, and submit a PowerPoint or a PDF presentation summarizing your deployment and results via the online submission form.

A committee member may follow up with you to ask clarifying questions. Finalists will present their project in a poster session at the conference.

Documentation required for consideration:

1. Provide a brief summary of your deployment (approximately 100 words)
2. Tell us about why your deployment should be the Deployment of the Year.
3. Please upload a PowerPoint presentation or a PDF of up to 25 slides about the deployment. In the presentation, please include:
  - Background information on your company
  - Overview of the Deployment – including the scope of deployment within the business, when it was implemented, how it was deployed, number of improvement personnel
  - Results – including impact on culture, financial, and other benefits
  - Unique Characteristics – anything unique and interesting about your deployment that has contributed to your success



**Additional requirements:** Winner must be present at the conference to accept the award in person.


To enter your project, you will need to answer a few questions and upload a PowerPoint presentation about your project via the online submission form.

  - Background information on your company
  - What the project was about
  - Results achieved
  - Key Lean Six Sigma Tools used and how they contributed to the outcome

1. Please provide a brief summary of your project (approximately 100-words)
2. Tell us why this should be the Innovation of the Year.
3. Please upload a PowerPoint presentation or a PDF of up to 25 slides. In the presentation, please include:

- Background information on your company
- What new and innovative approach was implemented, or what innovative product/process/service was developed
- What results were achieved and why this was important for your company
- What tools and approaches you used to achieve success
