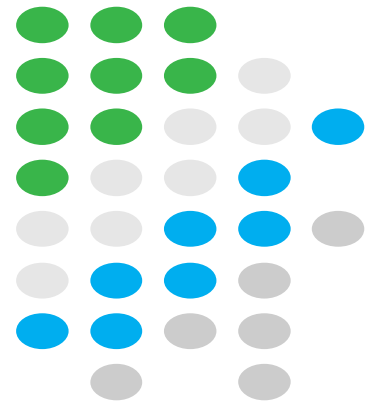

LSS Deployment of the Year

Are you part of an outstanding Lean and/or Six Sigma deployment?

We want to hear from you about why your deployment should win!

To enter your deployment, you will be asked to answer a few questions, and submit a Power Point or a PDF presentation summarizing your deployment and results via the online submission form.

A committee member may follow up with you to ask clarifying questions.

Documentation required for consideration:

1. Provide a brief summary of your deployment (approximately 100 words)
2. Tell us about why your deployment should be the Deployment of the Year.
3. Please upload a Power Point presentation or a PDF of up to 25 slides about the deployment. In the presentation, please include:
 - Background information on your company
 - Overview of the Deployment – including the scope of deployment within the business, when it was implemented, how it was deployed, number of improvement personnel
 - Results – including impact on culture, financial, and other benefits
 - Unique Characteristics – Anything unique and interesting about your deployment that has contributed to your success.



Additional requirements:

Winner must be present at the conference to accept the award in person.

To enter your project, you will need to answer a few questions and upload a Power-Point presentation about your project via the online submission form.

The committee will evaluate the posters at the conference to select the winning project.
